Multi Management Portfolio Management

The Multi Management Portfolio Management Team collaborate across departments to construct and manage a diverse range of Multi-Manager portfolios, including equities, fixed income, and multi-asset Investments. With a strong emphasis on risk management and innovative portfolio construction, the team is instrumental in generating returns that align with our client's objectives. MIA participants will get the opportunity to analyse market trends, engage with some of the world's top fund managers, and develop quantitative techniques to support Investment decisions. Joining the team provides you with the opportunity to develop your analytical skills, research the market, and collaborate with senior investment professionals in the industry.

Manager Research and Selection



The Manager Research and Selection Team is responsible for the monitoring of existing and selection of new external managers for the Mediolanum International Funds Buylist across both equity and fixed income strategies. The Buylist includes over I3O strategies totalling more than €60bn in assets under management. Members of the team are involved in detailed due diligence, blending qualitative and quantitative analysis to appraise a strategy's Investment footprint over time. In this rotation, MIA participants will gain direct exposure to the key decision makers on the strategies, be involved in research projects for appointing new managers and work closely with the Fund-of-Fund Portfolio Management team. During your rotation in the team, you will get the opportunity to work very closely with the Head of Manager Research and interact with some of the best fund managers across the globe.







The Fundamental Equity team are responsible for building and managing portfolios of stocks which form part of Mediolanum's funds. The work of the team involves identifying and researching companies and constructing portfolios from these companies with the goal of delivering industry leading investment returns. This process typically involves all aspects of fundamental analysis, including; financial analysis, industry research, equity valuation and meetings with company management. We also seek to identify market trends and opportunities and relay these across the Investment team. The focus of the Equity rotation is to gain an insight into portfolio management and start to develop the fundamental analysis skills necessary to become an analyst or portfolio manager. As part of the rotation within the Equity team, you will demonstrate your research in detailed reports and present your findings to the portfolio management team. You will be supported at every stage of this process by an experienced team.

Fund of Securities Fixed Income



The Fund of Securities Fixed Income team manages Mediolanum's direct Investments in debt securities. The team manages government and corporate debt Investments in developed and emerging markets. The aim is to add extra performance over and above portfolio benchmarks through a number of different performance levers including duration and yield curve positioning, credit exposure and FX allocations. These decisions are based on assessments of a number of performance drivers such as economic growth, inflation, fiscal policies, credit dynamics and politics.

In your rotation with the Fixed Income team, you will learn to analyse and assess the performance drivers and how they are used to value debt securities. You will learn how to assess the risk of these debt securities using bond metrics such as duration and credit risk. From this, you will learn how to construct portfolios taking account of the risk/return trade off. You will leave the rotation with a strong grasp of how and why bond markets behave the way they do which is very important as bond markets, and government bond markets in particular, have major influences on other asset classes such as equities.








Quantitative Investment

Recruitment Process

We have just 5 places on our Investment Academy each year and the selection process involves a comprehensive recruitment process.



The most suitable candidates will be selected to attend an interview with a member of the HR team and a senior member of the Investment team to give us a chance to get to know more about you as well as answer any questions you have about the organisation or programme. This will also give you a chance to showcase your knowledge of asset management and investment-related topics.

If successful after the 1st round, you have made it to the final stage of the process. Candidates will complete a Behavioural assessment and a final on-site interview which will include a case study that you will present to the Investment Leadership Team.

All final round candidates will then be contacted with feedback and potentially an offer to join our Mediolanum Investment Academy Programme in September 2026!
